

LCA-Abeka Hybrid Classes 6th-8th grade only

All hybrid students are considered full time students of LCA and are mandated to follow all rules and regulations of the LCA student and parent handbook. All students and parents are required to sign and abide by our Statement of Faith, All hybrid students in good standing with the school academically and behaviorally are allowed to participate in all field-trips and school musical programs.

A **University Model** is a hybrid model of education that blends traditional private or public schooling with homeschooling. Students attend classes on-campus a few days a week and complete coursework at home under the guidance of their parents, who serve as co-teachers. This model aims to leverage the strengths of both traditional and homeschooling approaches, providing students with a structured, yet flexible, learning environment.

Here's a more detailed look at the University-Model approach:

Hybrid Model:

Students spend a portion of the week in a central classroom setting with professional teachers and complete assignments and coursework at home under parental supervision.

Co-teaching:

Parents are actively involved in their children's education, serving as co-teachers and providing support for at-home learning.

University-Style Scheduling:

The schedule is often structured with students attending classes a few days a week and completing coursework at home on the remaining days, mirroring a university-style semester system.

Focus on Character and Discipleship:

Many University-Model schools emphasize character development and discipleship within a Christian framework.

Direct Parent Involvement:

Parents are actively involved in their children's education, reinforcing instruction provided by the school and supporting their learning at home

- 2. **Are hybrid classes eligible for scholarships?**Yes! Lincoln Christian Academy is an approved school for participation in the Scholarship Programs offered by the NCSEAA. - **3.** What are the class times and hours? Arrival begins at 7:30-7:55, Class begins at 8am and students are dismissed at 2:30.
- 4. **Do I get to choose my section of classes?** Yes, parents may choose their section up to 8 students per section. Once a section is full, parents are encouraged to choose the open section. **Sections are Monday through Wednesday and Wednesday-Friday.**
- **5.** Can I switch my section at any time? Students must request permission to switch a section from the Head of School. Section Switching may be done on an individual basis and must not exceed the section student to teacher ratio
- **6. How will the students communicate with the teacher?** Students will use Google Classroom to communicate and post assignments
- 7. **Do my hybrid students wear uniforms?** Yes, all students are required to wear uniforms. Uniforms can be purchased on LCA Website or on school link through Lands' End.
- **8. Do my hybrid classes include Chapel?** Yes, all students will attend Chapel on Wednesdays.
- **9. Do my hybrid classes include Bible lessons?** Yes, students will be required to participate in Bible lesson and memorization of scriptures
- **10. Are Bibles provided to hybrid students?** Yes, a Bible and Positive Action Curriculum will be provided to all students.
- 11. **Do the hybrid students follow all safety guidelines and procedures?** Yes, all students are required to participate in all safety drills and procedures.
- **12.** How and when does my hybrid child eat lunch? All students bring their lunch. Students eat lunch with their class at designated times. Parents are welcome to enjoy lunch with their child.
- **13.** Do my hybrid students bring snacks to class? Yes, bring a small peanut free snack daily and a reusable water bottle.
- **14.** Are the classes peanut free? Yes, peanut items are not allowed in the classrooms.
- **15.** Are the hybrid students responsible for daily reading and homework? Yes. Students are required to check their Google Classroom daily and respond as requested.

- **16.** How do my hybrid students get the correct Abeka supplies? LCA will purchase the correct books, computer, and Bible for each student.
- **17.** Can my hybrid student bring their own personal device? No, students are only allowed to bring their assigned devices from the LCA to ensure online safety while on campus.
- **18.** Do you offer After school care for hybrid students? No, students are required to be picked up by 3pm during their on site section
- **19. Will my hybrid student be able to bring cellphones to school?** No, cellphones are not allowed on campus by any LCA student.
- **20.** Will my hybrid student be able to bring cupcakes to celebrate their birthday? Yes, parents are encouraged to contact the teacher to plan properly to ensure the integrity of the classroom is not compromised. Students are not allowed to pass out birthday invitations while on campus.
